### \*\* Reading

**Mondays**-you have been receiving a worksheet to do at home over the 5 days of the week.

Depending on the activity on the back, you may or may not wish to return it.

**Wednesdays**-wordless stories that coincide with the letter of the week begin next week. These are for your child to write in and keep. Look for things in the booklets that begin with the letter of the week and have your child use inventive spelling to write it on the page. Inventive spelling is when a child prints only the sounds he hears. (i.e.-red for read, hows for house, etc.) try not to correct or spell for him/her.

**Daily**- Monthly reading lists as well as class books are also "reading" homework-look for the sticker in the upper right hand corner for those who use "inventive" spelling.

### \*\* Math-

Worksheets come home on Tues. or Thurs. with the date of the assignment stamped at the top.

Please return the completed sheet the next day.
